Suzanne LaFrance declares victory in Anchorage Mayor's Race

LaFrance now focusing on transition at City Hall

Anchorage, AK: With over 78,000 ballots now counted, Suzanne LaFrance has won the Anchorage mayor's race.

While every vote must and should be counted, the 5,487 votes separating LaFrance and Dave Bronson as of Monday are greater than the number of outstanding ballots expected, making a change in results statistically impossible.

"I'm grateful for all the support and the clear outcome of this election," said LaFrance. "As I've said throughout the campaign, local government isn't about left or right. It's about coming together to get things done. I'm excited about what we can do in this next chapter for Anchorage."

LaFrance is a registered nonpartisan and the first woman to be elected Mayor of Anchorage.



"This is a historic day for Anchorage," said campaign manager Katie Scovic. "No one worked harder for this outcome than Suzanne. Anchorage is lucky to have a leader who will refocus on the problems at hand and get our city back to work."

"Over the coming days and weeks, my team and I will be sharing more about the transition, what's ahead, and how to get involved," said LaFrance. "We've got a lot to do, but I'm ready to get to work as your mayor."
